Topic 7: October 18th is Homecoming and the Alumni Band will perform. Mr. Sisler will order the T-shirts for this event, which may be purchased and paid through the band PayPal account.

Topic 8: Megan Ledgerwood's senior project entails painting the back wall of the band room with the new Ram's logo, and Mr. Sisler would like her to possibly paint the opposite wall with the Alma Mater. Epinone Farber will be writing a documentary on the band for her senior project.

Topic 9: Mr. Sisler is obtaining information on the upcoming band trip, with TN being the targeted destination.

Topic 10: Mr. Sisler would like for the final concert in May, that will be performing Semper Fi, to be more of an "event" with possibly a scenario that resembles the band banquet. A dinner with live music, and recognition of senior band member and their families is one idea. Mr. Sisler will email Pam Reed for information regarding any potential cafeteria use restrictions.
